PRE-K FIELD TRIP TO KINDERGARTEN

The Pre-K classes will be having a field trip to J. B. Stephens, located at 1331 North Blue Road, to see the kindergarten classes on Friday, May 2. Even if your child is not going to J. B. Stephens, this is a good introduction to kindergarten for all Pre-K students. There will be babysitting available at the preschool starting at 9:10 for the AM and 12:40 for the PM. The cost for babysitting will be \$2.00 per child. Children in babysitting need to be picked up immediately after the field trip. Please let your child's teachers know if you need babysitting. The field trip will only last about 45 minutes, so an adult needs to stay with the preschooler. The teachers will be sending home a reservation note for this field trip. If there is not enough interest in going to the kindergarten class, this field trip will be cancelled and we will have regular class. The times are as follows:
